

Ready, Set, Drive!

Our driver education program is offered in cooperation with **Omaha Public Schools** and is proud to serve all students in the greater Omaha area.

Who Can Enroll:

- At least 15 years old and hold a valid Nebraska Learner's Permit (LPD) or Provisional Operator's Permit (POP) OR
- 14 year olds with a valid Nebraska Learner's Permit (LPE) attempting to obtain their School Permit (SCP) (check school permit eligibility in Nebraska Driver's Manual)

PARENTS: Your student will receive the greatest benefit from Driver Education if you work with him/her behind the wheel prior to and during class sessions.

Tuition:

- Includes classroom and behind-the-wheel instruction that meets or exceeds the State of Nebraska approved driver-training program for the Provisional Operator's Permit (POP).

Schedule:

- Classroom sessions are Monday and Wednesday OR Tuesday and Thursday from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- Behind-the-wheel drive sessions are on alternate days of classroom sessions. (See the registration form for drive time choices.)

For walk-in, mail, fax or phone registrations, confirmation and parental permission form will be mailed when your registration is processed. Permission form must be returned prior to start of class.

Reminder Letters:

- Reminder letters confirming dates/times will be sent approximately one week prior to the start of class.

Upon successfully passing both classroom and behind-the-wheel testing, students receive a certificate of completion. **Those under the age of 18 will also be issued a Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles waiver of testing. Please note: Students may not apply for their POP until they have held their Nebraska Learner's Permit for six months.** Please check POP restrictions in the Nebraska driver's manual.

Parents: Start Early! Talk to your teen while driving. Early learning will enhance driving later.

- When your teen is age 14, have your teen ride in the front seat while you drive. Explain the progression of defensive scanning skills; looking ahead, watching for other drivers.
- Have your teen identify all road signs and pavement markings and their meanings.
- Have your teen start judging when it is safe to turn left or right from a side street.
- Let your teen identify when it is safe to turn left at an intersection by checking the oncoming traffic.

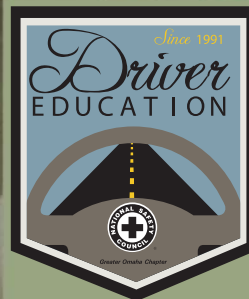

Driver Education

2010 Summer Schedule

Our summer schedule allows us to compress the required twenty hours of classroom and two to five hours of behind the wheel instruction in about a two week period and allows the student to earn their Nebraska Provisional Operators Permit (POP).

NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES (DMV) APPROVED DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM

In 2008, in Nebraska, teenage drivers represented only 7% of the total number of drivers, yet they accounted for 15.5% of the state's traffic fatalities, 24% of all reported crashes, 29% of all crashes between 9:00 PM and midnight and 43% of crashes where exceeding the speed limit was the major cause (www.dmv.state.net.us/highwaysafety).

Nebraska Office of Highway Safety confirms that students in Nebraska who complete an approved driver education program are **less likely** to be issued a citation or become involved in an accident.
