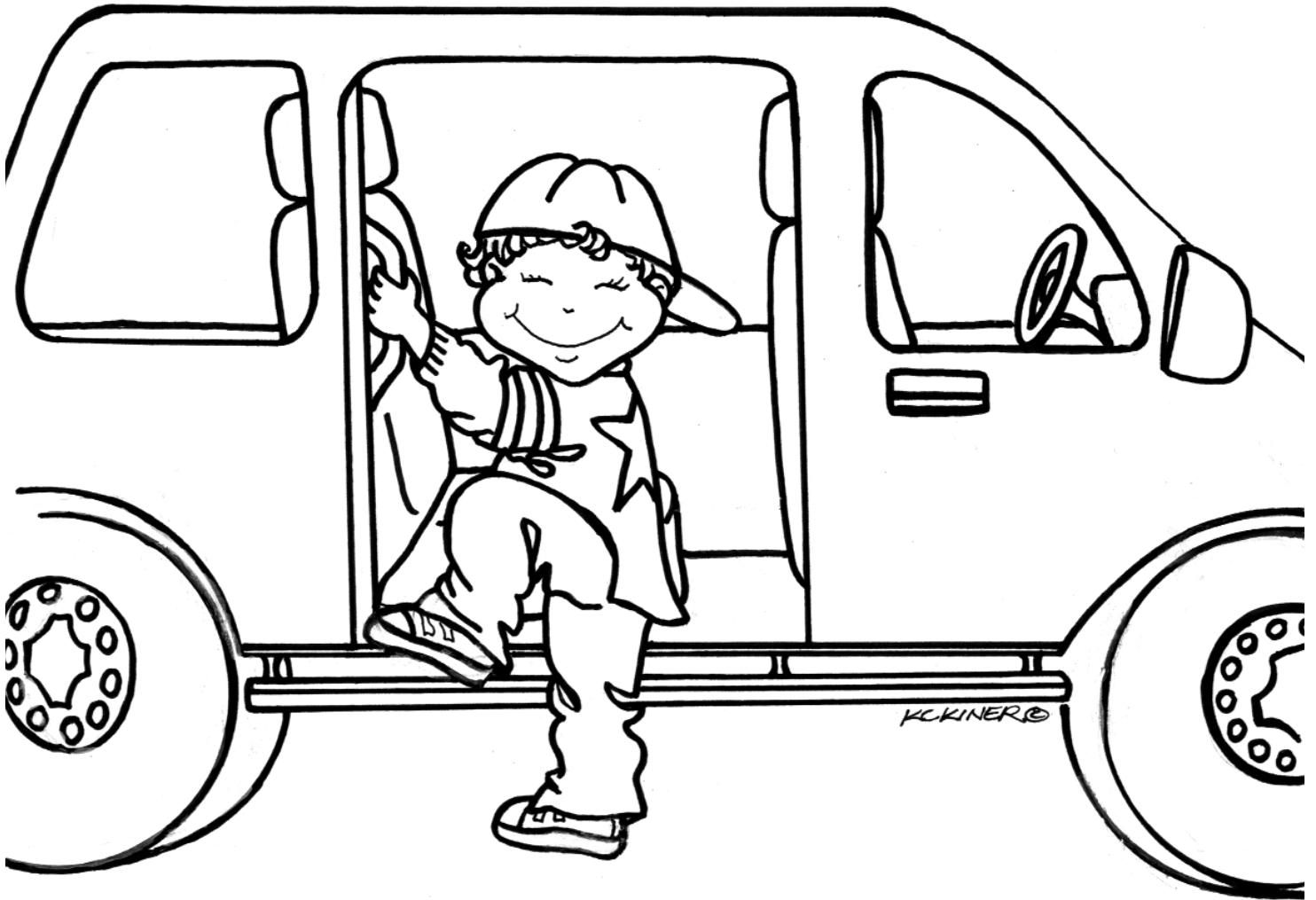

Nebraska CPS Law and Safety Belt Law:

All children up to six years of age must use a federally approved child passenger restraint system that is correctly installed. This is a primary law. You may be stopped, ticketed and fined for this violation.

Children, 6 to 18 years of age must always be buckled up. Remember, this also means no riding in truck beds or cargo areas. This is a primary law and you may be stopped and ticketed for this violation.

All persons being transported in a motor vehicle operated by a holder of a provisional operator's permit or a school permit must use an occupant protection system.
