

EPA Initial Lead Renovator

WHO MUST FOLLOW THE 2008 LEAD RULE'S REQUIREMENTS? Anyone who is paid to perform work that disturbs lead in housing and child-occupied facilities built before 1978. Examples include, but not limited to renovations that disturb paint or window replacement.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Residential rental property owners/manager; General contractors; Special trade contractors including, remodelers, painters, drywallers, window installers, electricians, plumbers, carpenters.

TOPICS INCLUDE:

The lead paint hazards, regulations, tools, personal protective equipment, work area setup, safe work practices, job completion procedures, and recordkeeping.

Under the new EPA rules that go into effect April 2010, contractors performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead, such as lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities and schools built before 1978 must be certified and must follow specific work practices to minimize occupant's exposure to lead hazards.

All individuals performing activities that disturb lead must be certified renovators or have been trained by a certified renovator. A certified renovator must also be assigned to each renovation project and perform all of the EPA-mandated responsibilities of a certified renovator.
