2012 DOT Reasonable Suspicion Training for Supervisors

Part 382 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSR) requires that driver supervisors receive 60 minutes of training be dedicated to alcohol misuse AND 60 minutes of training be dedicated to controlled substance abuse. Can you document that you've done this?
