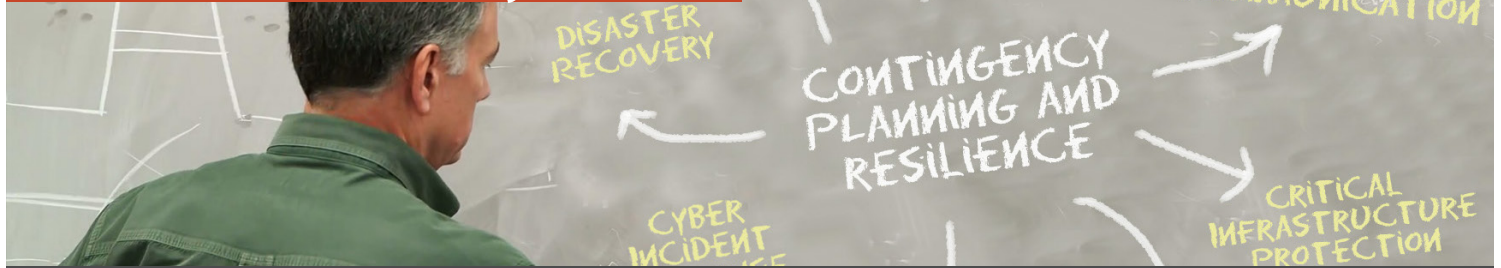

## WHY IT'S IMPORTANT

When preparing for emergencies, there is no room for shortcuts. From weather-related issues to active shooters in the workplace and more, it's critical for your employees to know the correct action to take before, during, and after an emergency.

### Certificate Program: Emergency Preparedness & Business Continuity
