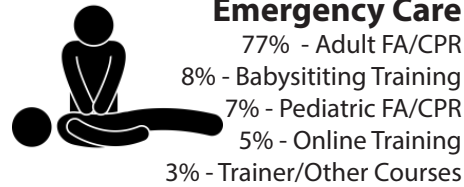
Our Mission

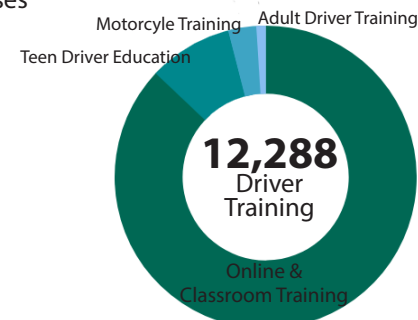
